MISSION

Liceu Terras do Engenho is committed to providing a high-quality, bilingual education that prepares students for higher education and lifelong success. The school fosters academic excellence, critical thinking, and global citizenship through an innovative and interdisciplinary approach.

COMMUNITY

Liceu Terras do Engenho is located in Piracicaba, São Paulo, Brazil, and serves a diverse student population from the city's upscale region. Piracicaba is a mid-sized city with a strong economic base in the industrial and agricultural sectors. The school is situated in a well-developed area, and the surrounding community includes families from a wide range of socioeconomic and educational backgrounds.

SCHOOL INFORMATION

Liceu Terras do Engenho is a private institution founded in 1993, offering education from Early Childhood through Grade 12. Located in Piracicaba, São Paulo, Brazil, the school serves a diverse student population in a well-developed region with a strong industrial and agricultural economic base.

The high school division (Grades 10–12) currently enrolls 157 students, with a graduating class (3rd year) of 48 students. The campus is equipped with modern science labs, a technology-equipped library, robotics classrooms, and sports facilities to support a holistic and interdisciplinary educational approach.

ACADEMIC CURRICULUM (BNCC)

The required curriculum follows Brazil's National Common Curricular Base (BNCC) and the formative itineraries established by Federal Law 13,415. All subjects listed below are mandatory, graded, and reported on the official high school transcript.

General education core (Formação Geral Básica): Portuguese Language, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, History, Geography, Philosophy, Sociology, and Physical Education.

Formative itinerary (Itinerário Formativo): Life Project, Text Production, Language, Literature and Culture of English-speaking Countries, Philosophy and Problem-Solving, Sociology and Scientific, Knowledge, Performing and Visual Arts, Data Analysis and Current Affairs, Research and Debate, Sports and Events (Sports Education), and Advanced Studies in Mathematics and Natural Sciences.

EXTRACURRICULAR PROGRAMS

The programs listed below are optional, fee-based offerings. They are not part of the required curriculum and are not included in students' grades or GPA.

- **Bilingual instruction** - [Systemic Bilingual](#): Science, Mathematics, History, and Geography taught in English. Offered only from Early Childhood through Middle School; not offered in High School.
- **Academic partnerships:** [Poliedro Learning System](#), [SEBRAE](#), [LIV](#), and [Zoom Education For Life](#).
- **Dual Diploma Program:** in partnership with [Washington Academy](#) (USA), including AP English Literature & Language, AP US History, and AP Calculus AB. Available only to students from 8th grade through the 2nd year of High School; introduced in 2025.
- **Extracurricular offerings:** include Robotics, Drama, Chess, Jiu-Jitsu, Financial Planning, Music, and Entrepreneurship.

STANDARDIZED TESTING & ACHIEVEMENTS

ENEM (Brazilian National High School Exam): The school consistently ranks among the top four institutions in Piracicaba for student acceptance into higher education via ENEM results.

Awards and Distinctions 2024–25: A student at Liceu Terras do Engenho was the only Brazilian to receive an award in the 2024 International Letter Writing Contest organized by the [Pulitzer Center](#).

GRADING AND GRADUATION

Grades are based on monthly and trimester examinations, coursework, and attendance. The minimum passing grade is 6.0 out of 10.0. The minimum attendance is 75%.

Graduation requirements: completion of the three years of Ensino Médio (Grades 10-12) following the Brazilian national curriculum (BNCC).
